We provide inclusive, culturally sensitive support for autistic individuals and their families.


Through tailored services—including Chinese-language resources, workshops, and support groups—we create nurturing spaces that foster understanding, emotional support, and empowerment.

Bellevue Advocacy Impact

Keynoted at **Bellevue City Hall** on Chinese-American neurodivergence needs, presented our support model, and advanced policy talks with city officials and cross-cultural partners.

There is much more to do to create a society that works for neurodivergent people

Asian children in the U.S. have the highest ASD diagnosis rate: 1 in 19 (5.4%) compared to the national average of 1 in 31 (CDC). Yet research shows they face systemic barriers to quality care.

While ASD affects all races equally, Asian children—like other minority and low-income groups—face delayed diagnosis, missing critical early intervention during key developmental stages.

Asian American autistic children face a double disparity: late diagnosis (1:88 prevalence) and substandard services compared to peers (Hasnain).


